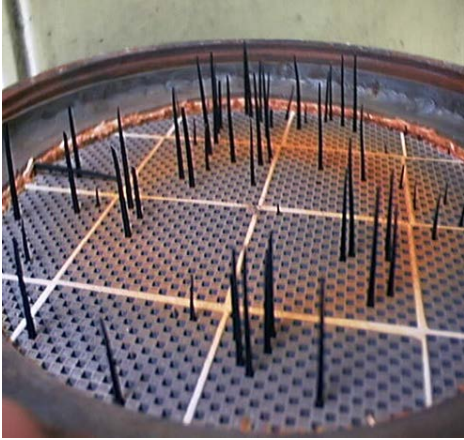


#1 Issue Causing Expensive Truck Down Situations = Emission Component Failures (example: DPF Failures).



#1 Reason for Emission Component Failures = Excessive Idling.

Best Solution = Webasto Engine & Air Heaters.

Webasto Engine Heaters / Air Heaters do the following...

- Reduce idling.
- Reduce downtime: Legal way to reduce emission component failures. Reduces the burden on emission controls.
- Keep DEF tanks and DEF injectors from freezing in cold climates. Block heaters do not circulate water. Thus you cannot thaw out a DEF tank with a block heater.
- Kit comes with a timer. Program the timer and never worry about the vehicle not pre-heating (saving wear on emission components) unlike relying on people to make sure the block heater is plugged in.
- Eliminate long engine warm ups (excessive idling / hard on engine and emission components).
- Engine heater eliminates cold starts: Cold starting is equivalent to 800 miles of driving (Truck Maintenance Council).
- Reduce Cold Dense Soot by up to 66% during engine start up.
- Allow the engine to start with warmer engine oil, sealing piston rings and decreasing engine blow-by decreasing the amount of "Carry Over" oil in the exhaust stream that shortens the life of the DPF.
- Increase exhaust temperatures rapidly, aiding in catalyst activity / regens.
- Engine heaters increase fuel efficiency by warming injectors.
- Reduce filter over loading and help increase the time between DPF cleaning intervals.
- Reduce face plugging from wet dense soot in the exhaust.
- Engine heaters and air heaters reduce engine wear and tear on the engine and critical components.
- Reduce fuel costs and downtime while keeping drivers comfortable!
